

Juices

Although many brands are pictured, you must buy the brand the store declares as the least expensive brand. This brand will vary from store to store.

Look for the pink sticker **WIC** Approved Item to find the brand you must buy in the store where you are shopping.

- A combination of frozen and canned juices may be purchased.
- All juices must be unsweetened and 100% juice.

Grapefruit, Orange, Pineapple, Orange Pineapple and Pineapple Orange (46 oz. cans)

Brands of grapefruit, orange, pineapple, orange pineapple and pineapple orange will vary.

You must buy the store's declared least expensive brand.

Orange & Grapefruit Juice (12 oz. frozen concentrate)

You must buy the store's declared least expensive brand.

Brands of grapefruit and orange juice will vary.
Calcium-fortified juice is NOT allowed.

Apple Juice (12 oz. frozen concentrate)

You must buy the store's declared least expensive brand.

Carrots and Tuna

Breastmilk is the best nutrition for infants. Breastfeeding women who do not get formula from WIC for their infants may also receive tuna and carrots.

Any brand
Fresh carrots – 1 or 2 lb. bags.
Canned sliced carrots – 14-16 ounces.
No baby carrots or carrots with tops.

Any brand
6 oz. cans, chunk light, packed in water only.
No albacore solid white.
